We are dedicated to changing the lives of individuals in need of substance abuse or co-occurring treatment. Our WestCare Offender Reentry Program serves adult men and women offenders and ex-offenders who are returning to the community from incarceration in Morgan County Jail or through probation and parole. This program provides direct treatment services and system linkages through an interconnected network of direct service provider partners. We provide direct and outpatient treatment services for substance use disorders and co-occurring disorders. Additionally, WestCare provides recovery support services that assist clients with employment, case management, relapse prevention, referrals, and assistance in locating housing, life skills, education, parenting education, and child development, and substance use education.

WestCare Tennessee also provides evidence-based Medication-Assisted Treatment (MAT) using FDA-approved medications and recovery support services (RSS) for those who have a Prescription Drug Opioid Addiction (PDOA).


WestCare operates criminal justice programs in three counties: Cocke, Jefferson, and Morgan Counties. The target population are high-risk/high-need, nonviolent offenders (adults 18 and older, both men and women), and non-sex offenders. As a certified vendor for U.S. and Federal Probation, WestCare provides random drug screens for clients on federal probation as well as outpatient treatment.

Education & Prevention

We utilize a variety of grassroots outreach efforts to increase community education on a variety of health, recovery, and social issues. Our goal is to educate the communities we serve in order to empower them to prevent alcohol and drug use, reduce harmful behaviors, and learn more about preventable health concerns. WestCare Tennessee is a certified vendor for the Tennessee Department of Children's Services (DCS) to provide services in homes with the goal of providing families with the necessary treatment to remain together or work towards family reunification. Through our Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) program, WestCare Tennessee focuses on preventing and reducing overdose deaths associated with opioids including illicit fentanyl and advancing a shared understanding of the patterns and characteristics of problem drug use in our local community. In partnership with the Eluna Network, WestCare Tennessee hosts Camp Mariposa, year-round addiction prevention and mentoring program for children ages 9-12 affected by the substance use of a family member. Youth attend free day and weekend camps throughout the year. Lastly, with a Centers For Disease Control and Prevention grant called Drug Free Communities, WestCare Tennessee, has strengthened an anti drug coalition, Prevention Alliance of Cocke County (P.A.C.C.), to educate and prevent substance use from youth up to adulthood. In addition to prevention programs for youth and adults, WestCare Tennessee in partnership with the Department of Veteran Affairs (VA), provides suicide prevention and other supportive services for Veterans and their families by way of the Veteran Empowerment Support Team (V.E.S.T), made possible by the Staff Sergeant Parker Gordon Fox Suicide Prevention grant.
