Together, we believe there is an opportunity for all individuals to lead fuller, richer lives.



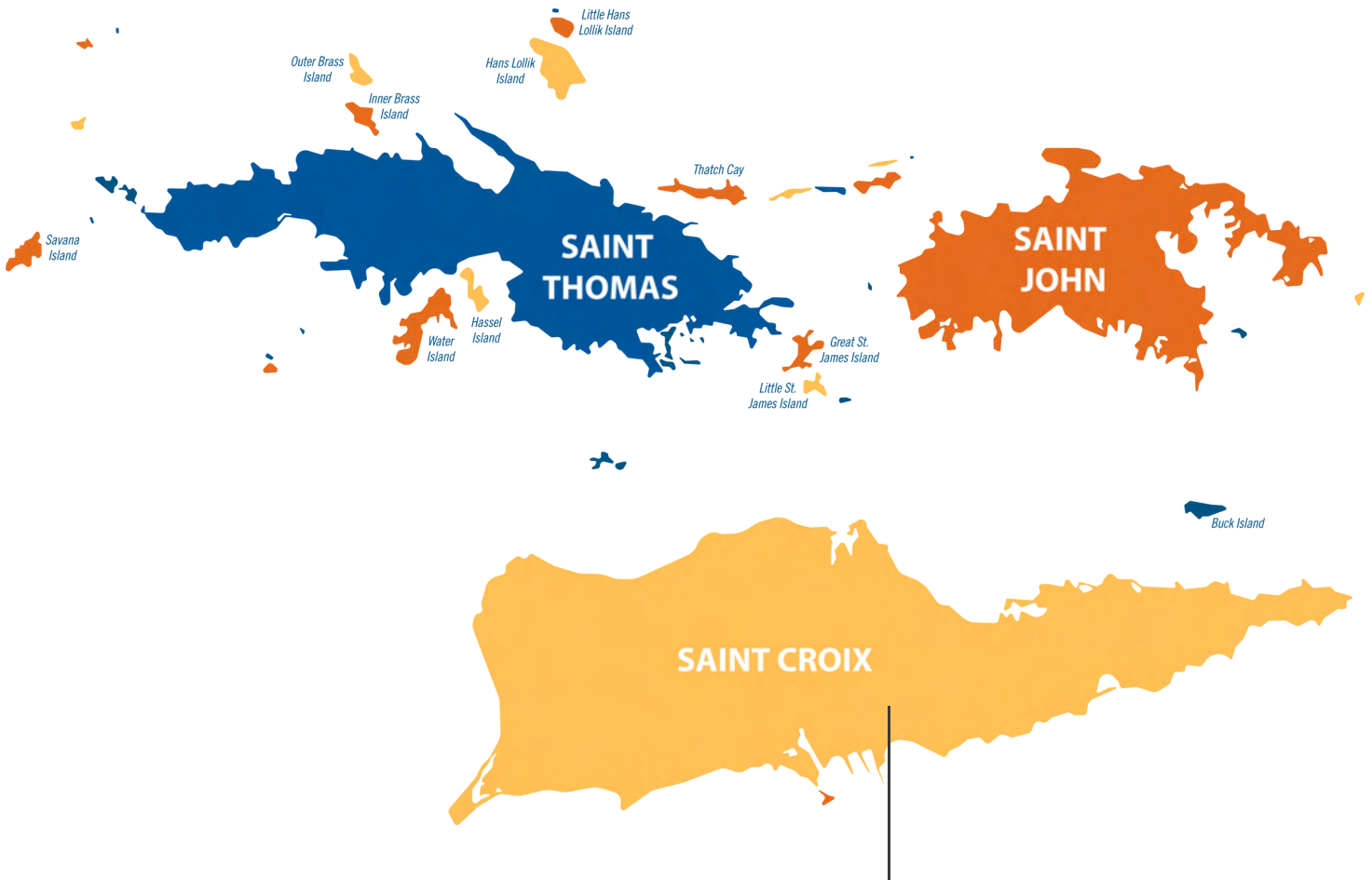
We are dedicated to changing the lives of individuals needing substance use or co-occurring treatment. The Village Sion Hill Therapeutic Community Program provides long-term residential, intensive alcohol, and other co-occurring treatment services. Our program is the only residential substance abuse treatment program in the area providing culturally relevant services. Services include individual and group counseling, alcohol and drug education classes, substance abuse and mental health education classes, medication management, life skills training, relapse prevention, referrals to community-based supportive services, 12-Step meetings, family and significant other education/support services, medical services, mental health treatment, and counseling. While located in St. Croix, we serve St. Thomas, St. John and other Caribbean neighbors with our program.

We utilize a variety of grassroots outreach efforts to increase community education on various health, recovery, and social issues. Through our Strength Project, WestCare helps parents learn nurturing skills that support their children by offering courses on parent training, youth skills training, and family life skills training. Upon completing our six to seven-week program, a graduation ceremony is held for all families to celebrate their achievements.
